- 4. BE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR OWN EQUIPMENT INCLUDING UNIFORM**
- 5. TREAT ALL COACHES AND OFFICIALS WITH RESPECT**
- 6. PLAY HARD AND CLEAN**
- 7. NO FOUL LANGUAGE OR OBSCENE GESTURES TO BE USED AT ANYTIME**
- 8. YOU HAVE AN OBLIGATION TO TEAMMATES & COACHES TO BE ON TIME FOR GAMES AND PRACTICES**
