



As you know, the Baldwin School District considers school safety and security of paramount importance in our community. This has been an area of increased focus in recent years due to tragic events that have unfolded throughout the country.

In accordance with established school safety plans developed by our school district, we would like to reiterate that during after school indoor activities, the Baldwin School District is required to provide security for all the schools used by the Baldwin PAL. There of course is a cost of this security that we all must be mindful of. In an effort to keep the cost of our programs at a reasonable rate we have worked in partnership with the school district to design a pilot security program and are asking for parents to volunteer to be front door monitors checking the PAL teams entering the buildings. Volunteers for this assignment would be eligible for free registration for their child the following year. Volunteers would be required to submit a background check and attend an orientation meeting conducted by school district staff, before our season begins, covering the duties and protocols of providing security and emergency procedures. If PAL cannot provide enough volunteers, we will be unable to continue our 2019 Fall programs at the low prices currently listed on the current flyer.
